Latest statistics: 390,031 positive cases, 5,773 deaths, 13,195 hospitalizations and 18 MIS-C cases (Multisystem Inflammatory Syndrome in Children associated with COVID-19). Since Friday, there have been 3,149 new cases, 7 deaths and 32 hospitalizations reported.



According to the Kansas WebIZ vaccination tracker (here), 2,826,547 doses have been administered in Kansas out of the 3,433,210 doses distributed. 1,554,692 people (50.6% of the population) have had their first dose; 1,257,299 (45.0%) have had their second doses; and 14,557 have had their third dose of the vaccine series.

SAMHSA awards \$123 million in grants for multifront approach to combat the nation's overdose epidemic. According to the CDC, there were more than 94,000 fatal overdoses for the 12 months ending January 2021, a 31% increase from the year prior. COVID-19 is only adding to the urgency of the mission.
